A BRAND NEW BEER IS ON DECK – CRITICAL MASS TRAPPIST SINGLE!

NEWEST IN DIPA SERIES LUPULOR CENTENNIAL

Double IPA /9.3% ABV / 99.8 IBU

TASTING NOTES: A very complex beer that packs a hop wallop. While it's very high in IBU's (99.8) it's also very balanced with a rich malt complexity, but it is not overly sweet. There are seven varieties of hops in this beer which adds to the complexity. It is dry hopped Centennial hops which give a distinct piney flavor and aroma.

OUR POPULAR PILSNER IS BACK! SEGGEBRUCH

German Style Pilsner/5.2% ABV / 44 IBU

TASTING NOTES: Distinct pilsner malt character with a beautifully floral/grassy hop aroma. There's plenty of bitterness without being overwhelming. A breadly malty flavor that is well balanced with hop bitterness and a long dry finish.

NEW FLAVOR!! PERSNICKETY PINK PONY

Tart Cherry Berliner Weisse /3.7% ABV / 4.8 IBU

TASTING NOTES: As you bring the glass to your lips the aroma of Montmorency cherries overwhelms your sense of smell. In the back ground there is a light aroma of baking bread from the copious amount of wheat malt to compliment the cherries. At first sip there is a pleasant tartness from the acidity created in the boil kettle. The cherry is very pleasant and compliments the tartness. The beer finishes pleasantly tart, dry, fruity and refreshing!

IT'S BACK! BALMORAL

Best Bitter /4.0% ABV / 40.2 IBU

TASTING NOTES: A traditional English pale ale that is a staple in British Pubs. The beer showcases the caramelly goodness of English malt and peppery noble hops. Very balanced with notes of fruit esters and moderate bitterness. Truly quaffable as the alcohol is low compared to most American pale ales.

CONNEMARA

Irish Stout /4.4% ABV / 40.2 IBU

TASTING NOTES: A unique beer in that it's pitch black but not heavy at all. Bitterness is not only derived from hops but also from roasted un-malted barley. You won't see any light through this beer but it is very quaffable and pleasing. Notes of dark chocolate and espresso without a lot of malt sweetness. It finishes quite dry and refreshing.

OUR FLAGSHIP BEERS & YEAR-ROUND BEERS

TROT HOPPLE

India Pale Ale /6.7% ABV / 67 IBU

TASTING NOTES: An amber colored ale with firm initial bitterness. Pleasant notes of caramel mid-palate with a large dose of piney/citrusy hop aroma and flavor. The bitterness goes a long way into the finish for a pleasing crispness. Overall this is a very balanced beer that exemplifies the character of the Citra Hops that is used for the dry hop.

#1 SELLER - DOWNTOWN HOTTIE

American Wheat / 5.7% ABV / 17.2 IBU

TASTING NOTES: Bright golden in color beneath a frothy white head. It has a crisp and refreshing taste and a silky mouthfeel from the wheat.

SERGEANT RECKLESS

American Pale Ale /5.6% ABV / 44.7 IBU

TASTING NOTES: Deep gold in color with an initial citrus/fruity hop aroma. Malt sweetness and caramel notes are well balanced with the flavor of hops and moderate bitterness. Citrus/Fruity hop finish well balanced with notes of caramel.

KNIGHTMARE

Scottish Ale /7% ABV / 23.1 IBU

TASTING NOTES: A rich ruby red colored ale that exemplifies the virtues of Scottish Malt. A rich malt sweetness with just a hint of peppery bitterness. Loaded with notes of caramel and toffee with very little hop flavor. A long toasty, sweet finish

PAXON THE PONYLESS

English Porter /5.7% ABV / 45.2 IBU

TASTING NOTES: Robust and rich yet smooth and silky. Notes of coffee and dark chocolate dominate the flavor with a good finishing balance of sweetness and bitterness. The beer accomplishes being rich and flavorful without being overly sweet or heavy.

LEAPING BULL

Hefeweizen /5.5% ABV / 12.9 IBU

TASTING NOTES: Creamy malt sweetness from the wheat as well as notes of clove and banana that are unique to the yeast used in this brew. Notably hazy from the yeast in solution but with light golden straw color. Sometimes served with a lemon.

SMOKE THE DONKEY

New England Style IPA/6.8% ABV / 40.1 IBU

TASTING NOTES: Deep golden in color, low in bitterness and noticeably hazy. There is a big tropical fruit aroma from the hops with a nice malty background. We purposely added the majority of the hops at the end of the boil as well as double dry hopping with Comet and Bravo hops. The flavor is noticeably full of juicy tropical fruit flavors from the hops as well as the silky malt sweetness

NONETHEWIZER

AMERICAN LIGHT LAGER/4% ABV/10.6 IBU

TASTING NOTES: A Standard American Light Lager. If craft beer isn't your thing then this brew is for you! A very simple beer using American Pilsen Malt and very lightly hopped. It has a dry, crisp finish that leaves with the taste for another!
